
Maryland JCI Senate Foundation Scholarship Application

For Trade/Vocational School Scholarship

Eligibility: Graduating high school seniors in Maryland. **You must be a U.S. citizen to apply for this scholarship.**

This package contains information and directions for applying to the Maryland JCI Senate Foundation Scholarship Program. A \$1,500 grant will be awarded to a graduating high school senior in Maryland, who plans to continue their education at a trade or vocational school. The monies must be used for educational expenses in the first year of full-time study. Checks awarded will be made out in the name of the recipient and the educational institution of their choice.

Instructions for applying for the MD JCI Senate Foundation Scholarship

Please read the following points carefully.

1. Submission preference will be in a Microsoft Word or pdf compatible format. A typed or neatly hand printed (blue or black ink only) submission will also be accepted if scanned and emailed.
2. Included in this application package are all the necessary forms. Your application packet pages should include the following information:

- Applicant Information
- High School Contacts
- Trade/Vocational School information
- Parent or Guardian Information
- Personal Statement (no more than 500 words)
- School Acceptance Letter (if applicable)
- Supporting documentation of your choice (awards, certificates, articles, pictures, etc).
 - Limit three (3) sheets
- Reference letters – at least 1, not more than 3 references – *see #4*
- Signature – *see #6*
- Transcripts (grades and state) – *see #5*

3. Your personal statement is limited to 500 words.

4. At least one reference letter should be from a trades teacher.

5. Your school transcript should be the very last attachment to your application package.

6. Sign the bottom of the Personal Statement section.

7. **Each student must have an active, working email address listed. PLEASE PRINT OR TYPE.**
