Erica Weems Memorial (EWM) Scholarship

The EWM Scholarship was established in memory of Erica Weems who was killed in a car accident on the morning of August 30, 2007. Erica graduated from Calvert High School in 1988, and attended St. Mary's College and earned her Bachelor of Arts Degree in Foreign Languages from George Mason University in 1994.

Erica, aka Lady Cavalier, was a very athletic young lady, she was recognized as "Most Valuable Player," and a dominant player in volleyball and basketball throughout her middle and high school years. Her performance in track afforded the team All-SMAC championship in her junior and senior years of high school. She was apart of the Women's Basketball team at George Mason University. She also received recognition for volunteering in assisting with the Special Olympics.

She shared her abilities and talents in many different capacities including: coach, assistant coach, teacher of Alternative Education and Spanish at Patuxent High School, coach for Southern Maryland Storm AAU Basketball, player of the Bartlett Services Women's League, case manager at the Southern Maryland Community Network, and counselor at the Southern Maryland Junior Police Academy for two years. She served in many capacities in her church as well, children's Sunday school teacher, church administrator and praise team/choir member, just to name a few.

This scholarship will be awarded to two female scholar athletes, in the amount of \$1000 each.

Procedures:

- 1. All applications must be submitted to the guidance office on or before April 15th.
- 2. Along with the application, students must attach an essay (see application).
- 3. The coach's recommendation form will need to either be sent to the guidance office OR given to applicant to attach with the application in a sealed envelope.
- 4. EWM Scholarship Committee will review the applications and make the final selections. Applicants will be judged on a combination of academics, athletic accomplishments, the essay and coach's recommendation.

Requirements:

- 1. Female athlete
- 2. A senior at an accredited Calvert County High School and planning to attend college
- 3. Must demonstrate strong character and positive outlook on life
- 4. Coach's recommendation (at least one)
- 5. Required Essay
