**Please attach the following items to your application and sign below:**

- A typed double spaced essay of no more than 250 words describing the candidate's commitment to becoming an elementary or secondary educator. Include prior experiences working with children. This essay should mention the grade level/s and/or subject/s that the candidate would like to teach.
- An official Transcript and CCPS Grade Report (showing attendance for at least two years) from the student's counselor. The student is required to have a B or better average for at least the last two years of high school.
- A copy of a letter of acceptance from a college or university.
- A statement about the need for financial assistance. A CSS analysis or a parental statement may be attached. What will be the total cost of your first year of school or college? Include tuition, room and board, and books in your cost estimate. What portion of this amount will you be paying yourself? Include in this statement any special consideration such as health costs or other educational expenses which you would like the committee to consider in making its decision.
- Two Letters of Reference from Teacher, Guidance Counselor, and/or former employer.

The \$2,000 award for this scholarship will be paid by the Calvert Education Association directly to the college or university that the scholarship recipient will be attending.
