2. SCHOLARSHIP:

Scholarship recipients from each of the eight zones outlined in the application form, covering Maryland and Washington, D.C., will receive a \$1,008.11 single-year scholarship to a two-year or four-year college, university or technical school. Students must be on track to graduate by June 2017 to be considered for the scholarship program. Students must also be enrolled in a two-year or four-year college, university or technical school by Aug. 3, 2017 to receive the scholarship.
