Optimist Club of Calvert-Prince Frederick Career/Vocational/Technical Scholarship - \$3,000

The Optimist Club of Calvert-Prince Frederick, through the Calvert Optimist Community Parks Foundation, Inc., awards an annual scholarship providing financial assistance to students graduating from Calvert County public high schools seeking post-secondary career education, vocational or technical training (up to a two-year program) at any trade or technical school, college or university approved by the Optimist Club of Calvert-Prince Frederick which results in the applicant being awarded an accredited vocational certification or an Associate's Degree.

The \$3,000 scholarship is paid at the rate of \$1,500 each year and must be used for career education, vocational or technical training. Payments are made directly to the student in advance of the fall semester each year.

REQUIREMENTS

- 1. Applicants must be residents of Calvert County, MD and be in the current graduating class of a Calvert County public high school.
- 2. Children, stepchildren, and grandchildren of members of the Optimist Club of Calvert-Prince Frederick are not eligible for this award.
- 3. Only applicants seeking post-secondary education/training to achieve vocational certification, or an Associate's Degree will be eligible for consideration of this award.
- 4. Applicants must be accepted in a two-year certification or associate degree program approved by the Optimist Club of Calvert-Prince Frederick, prior to distribution of any award.
- 5. Scholarship funds for ensuing year will be paid during the month of August, directly to the student, upon the receipt of a certificate of enrollment for the fall semester and a copy of the student's current transcript. (Mail transcript to address listed in No. 4 of Procedures Section.)
- 6. Scholarship awards are scheduled for two (2) annual payments. Any lapse due to temporary/personal circumstances of up to one year will be permitted, if the recipient advises the Optimist Club of Calvert-Prince Frederick of the need to defer/delay payment. Failure to advise the Optimist Club of the need to defer payment may result in forfeiture of any future scholarship award payment.
- 7. The scholarship recipient is expected to attend the June 10, 2019 meeting of the Optimist Club of Calvert-Prince Frederick to receive their award.

PROCEDURES

- 1. Applications will be reviewed and the final selection for the successful awardee will be made by a committee consisting of members of the Optimist Club of Calvert-Prince Frederick. If the selected recipient chooses not to utilize the award, an alternative recipient will be chosen by this committee.
- 2. Applicants will be judged on character, citizenship, scholastic ability, community service and financial need. Recommendations from various organizations (school, church, Scout programs, 4-H, etc.) will be sought when deemed pertinent and necessary.
- 3. Applications are available from the Guidance Office at the Calvert County public high school from which the applicant will be graduating or contact the Scholarship Committee (410-257-7012).
- 4. Applications <u>MUST BE RECEIVED</u> by the Scholarship Committee on or before <u>April 15, 2019</u>. Late applications <u>will not</u> be accepted. Mail <u>one</u> copy of a completed application with <u>all</u> required information and attachments (incomplete applications will not be considered) to:
