Optimist Club of Calvert-Prince Frederick Career/Vocational/Technical Scholarship - \$3,000

The Calvert-Prince Frederick Optimist Club, through their Calvert Optimist Community Parks Foundation, Inc., has established an annual scholarship providing financial assistance to students graduating from Calvert County high schools for continued career education or training (up to a two-year program) at any college, university, trade or technical school approved by the Optimist Club of Calvert.

The \$3,000 scholarship is paid at the rate of \$1,500 each year and must be used for career education, vocational or technical training. Payments are made directly to the student in advance of the fall semester each year.

PROCEDURES

- 1. Applications will be reviewed by a committee consisting of members of the Optimist Club of Calvert-Prince Frederick and the final selection for the successful awardee will be made by this committee. An alternative will be named if the winner chooses not to utilize the award.
- 2. Applicants will be judged on character, citizenship, scholastic ability, and financial need. Recommendations from various organizations (school, church, Scout programs, 4-H, etc.) will be sought when deemed pertinent and necessary.
- 3. Applications should be obtained from the guidance office at the various high schools or from the Scholarship Committee (410-257-7012).
- 4. Applications <u>MUST BE RECEIVED</u> by the Scholarship Committee on or before <u>April 15, 2017</u>. Late applications <u>will not</u> be accepted. Mail <u>one</u> copy of a completed application with all required information (incomplete applications will not be considered) to: Optimist Scholarship Committee, c/o Betty Knapp, 8233 Pushaw Station Road, Owings, MD 20736. The scholarship recipient will be notified by letter in late May.
- 5. The scholarship recipient is expected to attend the June 12, 2017 meeting of the Optimist Club to receive their award.

REQUIREMENTS

- 1. Applicants must be residents of Calvert County, MD and be in the current graduating class of a Calvert County high school.
- 2. Children, stepchildren, and grandchildren of members of the Optimist Club of Calvert-Prince Frederick are not eligible for this award.
- 3. Scholarship funds in ensuing years will be paid during the month of August directly to the student upon receipt a certificate of enrollment for the fall semester and a copy of the student's current transcript. (Mail transcript to address listed in No. 4 above.)
- 4. Scholarship awards are scheduled for two annual payments; a lapse due to temporary personal problems of up to one -year will be permitted, if the recipient advises the Calvert-Prince Frederick Optimist Club of the need to defer/delay payment. Failure to advise the Optimist Club of the need to defer payment will result in forfeiture of future scholarship award payment.
